EKU Coach Certification Programme

13 October 2024

With the aim of improving the quality of Kabaddi across England, the EKU is issuing the following criteria for EKU coach certification programme:

Objective criteria for EKU coach certification programme

Coaching certification level	Requirements
Level 1	 3+ years of playing Kabaddi (Rectangle); 1+ years of being a first team captain of an affiliated university club;
Level 2	 5+ years of playing Kabaddi (Rectangle) OR Coached an EKU affiliated Kabaddi club / team for 2+ years; Represented England at 1+ international tournament(s) OR Coached the England team 1+ times;
Level 3	 7+ years of playing Kabaddi (Rectangle) OR Coached an EKU affiliated Kabaddi club / team for 3+ years; Represented England at 3+ international tournament(s) OR Coached the England team 2+ times; Completed a recognised international coach training course;

Subjective criteria for EKU coach certification programme

Being an EKU qualified coach requires you to fulfil certain subjective criteria that are essential to being a coach. These relate to leadership, ability to teach, communication, commitment and accountability.

Issuance of coach certificates

The EKU, in its sole discretion, may issue or revoke coach certificates to any individual based on the above provided objective and subjective criteria, as well as the policies of the EKU.

Coach certificates shall only be issued, with a validity of 1 year at a time, upon receiving a request and such requests shall be entertained for reasons that align with the EKU's objective of promoting and developing the sport of Kabaddi in England. There may be an annual fee associated with the issuance of the certificate, which shall be communicated upon receipt of such requests from time to time.
