Subjective criteria for EKU Referee Certification Programme

Being an EKU certified referee requires you to fulfil certain subjective criteria that are essential to being a referee. These relate to integrity, discipline, commitment and performance.

Issuance of referee certification

The EKU, in its sole discretion, may issue or revoke referee certificates issued to any individual based on the above provided objective and subjective criteria, as well as the policies of the EKU.
